Allegations

Including comments from the complainant

Wrongful Search

Patted me down, emptied my pockets and detained me. Put me into a temp holding cell at the station while we waited for the DCR and FBI. They may or may not have looked into my personal vehicle. No crimes committed, no threats/violence and no charges, meaning these searches are all wrongful.

Wrongful Detention

I was told I wanted to only be questioned briefly back at the station. I wasn't being arrested, no threats or anything changed against me. No rights were read to me, no wrong doing and wasn't handcuffed. (Just used zip-ties and secured in their car.) I was to be released. (Talking about the illegal activities, Antifa/AFA/ARA and drugs/prostitutes in the clubs, like the DNA/Thorn organization. it would be safer at the station, instead of the bar or out in the open.)

Bias-Based Policing

Inquiring about why I shave my head, looking like a nazi and racist. Saying my people or "those" people are "bad" and you shouldn't go down that road. Also they spoke how "your people" do drugs also and part of a prostitution ring. Agent Doug Capra started to label other people and said something about a "hatchet" Steevers. Wanted to know more information on him. I thought hatchet like the tool or even juggalos/Insane Clown Posse fans. They used some psychology that I remember from school and then we talked about authors like Harold A. Covington. Like "how do you know him?" I would go silent/pause because I don't know and feel embarrassed. I was told I couldn't inform for them and then placed on a terror watch list / person of interest list. (I still don't know why or what any of that even means.) I WASN'T ALLOWED TO DEFEND OR EXPLAIN ANYTHING ELSE. I WASN'T EVEN ASKED FOR MUCH OF ANYTHING OTHER THAN WE HAVE TO OBSERVE AND REPORT ON YOUR BEHAVIOR FOR AWHILE. (I didn't agree with them, told them that it was all wrong but still complied/didn't want to get hurt.)

Repeat Harassment

FBI Special Agent Doug Capra from Seattle, WA field office and Sergeant Howser of Olympia PD / maybe others have e-mail (plus phone calls), including the so-called "manager" of The Society/Room 120 nightclub and bar, Zak Burgess or sometimes Alex Bosi. (I've found out they don't like me and lie to everyone online, at the bar, around town, etc. about my family)

Neglect of Duty

Should have also apprehended / detained the others involved at the club. Also tracked the hacker of my Facebook/google accounts or at least verified the authentication and authorship of the evidence. [Federal Rule of Evidence 901] They should have also NOT listened to any HEARSAY or OPINION of this bartender (differs) that tells people he is a hero (doing his PUBLIC SERVICE to END facism/nazi/Trump).

Story

I'VE NOT COMMITTED ANY CRIMES, NO THREATS and NOT CHARGED WITH ANYTHING!

I was placed on a terror watch list / FBI person of interest list and the Federal Rule of Evidence 901 law, states "when admitting Social Media into court as evidence, proof of content authentication and authorship are required" was thrown out 'supposedly' because of it. I haven't yet been able to restore my rights or get defense counsel. The FBI Seattle Field Office and Olympia Police Department are

refusing to FOLLOWUP or even speak with me now.

Calls For Service Report, Agency: Olympia Police Department - Nature of Incident "Public Service" on 03/11/2019 case # 2019-01461 and Calls For Service Report: Oly PD - crime of "mental problem" on 03/26/2019 case # 2019-01776. I'm unable/prevented/having difficulties obtaining records with the FBI/OPD/court and any actual evidence that was supposedly used against me. These include but not limited to transcripts, plus copies of Superior Court of WA - County of Thurston Case No. 19-6-00140-34 (Filed Mar 29 2019). This was in retaliation to the reports of myself speaking AGAINST data mining/collection, other illegal activities/terrorism (Antifa/AFA/ARA support) and a privacy problem downtown at The Society nightclub in Olympia, WA. These issues seem to keep returning every year, just like at The Foundation nightclub in Seattle in 2018 and hurt many businesses. There may or may not be any relation but my Facebook account was also HACKED and deleted/unrecoverable. I was sent to Telecare Thurston Mason E&T, want to report/investigate the facility for Improper Use of Restraint (outside the scope of the law, that made me exceptionally drowsy/sleepy during the day and lazy, not wanting to do much of anything, all FORCED upon me WITHOUT evidence or history). They gave me Brexpiprazole (Rexulti), an Antipsychotic and I had NO/ZERO idea why it was needed or why I was being forced to take it. The claim is due to the POLICE/FBI information that was provided to them and they MUST OBEY! My actual prescribing medical team doesn't agree with that medicine and didn't even know about it either. Their team/facility lied about a condition. I AM NOT PRESCRIBED ANY ANTIPSYCHOTIC and don't need any as said by my medical team.

Gold-Level Complaint

This user opted to share more complete details about their police experience than a Basic Complaint.

Wrongful Search

Allegation: Police conducted a search without a warrant, probable cause, or consent.

Wrongful Detention

Allegation: Police pulled over a vehicle or stopped someone without reasonable suspicion.

Bias-Based Policing

Allegation: An officer's conduct was based on a person's race, gender, appearance, nationality, religion, age, gender, sexual orientation, residence, disability, etc.

Repeat Harassment

Allegation: Circumstances where a department member has had repeated or continued contact with a person without lawful police justification.

Neglect of Duty

Allegation: The officer's inaction did not follow appropriate policy, procedure, or guidelines. These are things an officer should have done, but didn't do.
